



## Report on Fire Safety Drill

Date: 13/09/2024

**“Safety isn't expensive; it's priceless – especially with fire.”**

On September 13, 2024, a comprehensive fire safety class and drill were conducted at Askari Universal School by the Fire Department of Mehasana. The session was tailored for both teachers and staff, aiming to enhance their awareness and preparedness for fire emergencies.

  - Techniques for using a fire hose effectively.
