National Mathematics Day

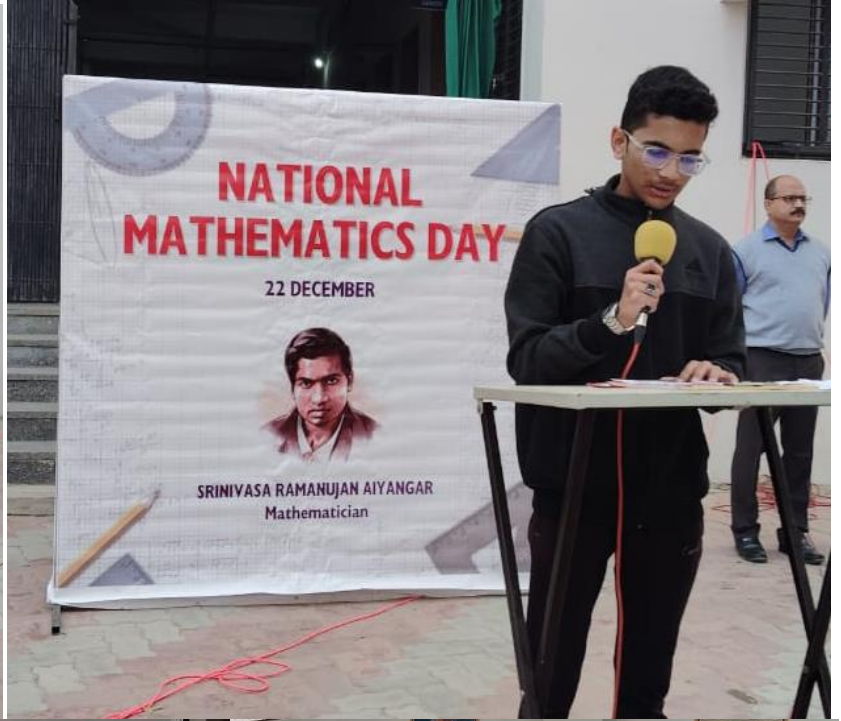
December 22 a tribute to genius Srinivasa Ramanujan.

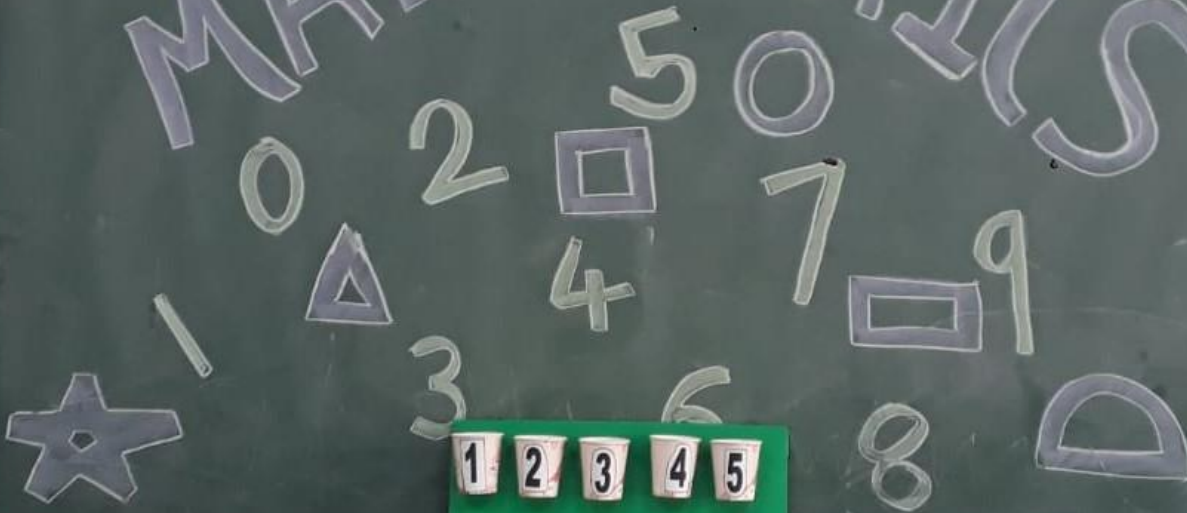
